Biography

In the summer of 2007 Sarah Schieber along with her husband, Chad, a fifteen year veteran of the Midland (Michigan) Police Department, were on the verge of launching a new ministry to married couples. It was intended to compliment Sarah's growing music ministry. After singing in a regional Christian group for nearly a decade, Sarah had just finished her debut solo CD entitled *Gratitude*. However, that October, while running in the Chicago Marathon, Chad collapsed at mile 18 and within minutes had gone home to be with the Lord. Sarah found herself widowed at the age of 33 and left with three young children. She also found all of her hopes and dreams shattered. But God is faithful and He has led Sarah down a long and painful journey to a place of hope and healing. Along the way, God has used music to bring her through some of her darkest valleys, including the song "Christmas In Heaven." Sarah recorded and released this song to Christian radio in December of 2008 and it climbed to #15 on the national Soft AC/Inspirational chart published by *Radio & Records*, the industry's leading magazine. Sarah sold nearly 4,000 copies of the CD single from her home. Sarah has just released a new CD entitled THE LONG OCTOBER ROAD. The songs from this new project were inspired by the pages of her journal following Chad's death. A companion book with the same title is due out in the fall of 2009.

"Mine is a message of hope to everyone," shares Sarah. "It encourages them to become deeply rooted in their relationship with Christ so that when that moment in life happens that they hope will never happen, they can stand. It is about knowing that when that time comes, we can be assured that God is faithful and everything promised in His Word is true! I know, because I've been there!"
